- PERFECTLY EVEN SKIN** A lightweight base that won't cake.
- PLAYED-UP CHEEKBONES** Shimmery bronzer to add contours.
- DEFINED EYES** Neutral shadows in shades of caramel and beige to impart depth without looking trendy or overly done.
